

## **CV Tobias Kleinjung, MD**

Tobias Kleinjung, MD, born in Gießen/Germany, studied medicine at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University in Munich/Germany from 1988 to 1995, from 1995 to 2002 residency at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology, University of Regensburg/Germany. In 2001 he completed his specialist training in otorhinolaryngology. From 2002-2010 senior physician at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology, University of Regensburg/Germany. Since 2011 head of the outpatient clinic and Professor at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology at the University Hospital of Zurich/Switzerland. Since 2013 head of the sialendoscopy unit at the same affiliation.

Clinical focus: otology and neurotology, tinnitus, sudden deafness, diseases of salivary glands.

Focus of research: new treatment strategies in sudden hearing loss and tinnitus, treatment of chronic tinnitus with neuromodulation (TMS, neurofeedback), neuroimaging of tinnitus, auditory neuroplasticity, cochlear implantation in single sided deafness,

Publications: multiple articles on tinnitus and hearing loss in scientific journals, co-editor of “Textbook of Tinnitus” (Springer, 2011) and “Tinnitus – Pathophysiology and Treatment” (Elsevier, 2007)
